Creatures of the animal kingdom, be they furry, web-footed, hooved, winged or whiskered, are the subject matter for **Fiddle Dee Dee**, named after the folk song about the fly who married the bumblebee. Featuring a range of 'fiddle' playing styles (from classical violin to folk style fiddling) and other relatives of fiddles, such as the sitar of India.

On the home CD's you'll hear emphasis on the string instrument family, with instruments such as the mandolin, banjo, lute, classical and folk guitar, harp, string quartet and double bass. And of course, there is the home instrument, the **Fiddlesticks**. Sporting the stripes of a bumblebee, **Fiddlesticks** are a one-of-a-kind Kindermusik instrument that can be rattled, rolled, tapped and otherwise fiddled with to create fun sounds and play possibilities.

You will be treated to an ample and diverse collection of music. In addition to the variety of stringed instruments already mentioned, the Home CDs include music representing many cultures.

Two beautiful books – *Animal Kingdom* and *This Little Piggy Played the Fiddle*, are uniquely designed for the curricular content with lots of creativity and musical learning.
